Second Class Rank Requirements:

"Identify or show evidence of at least 10 kinds of wild animals (birds, mammals, reptiles, fish, mollusks) found in your community.": ORIGEN, Nature Exchange, Resource Library

First Class Rank Requirements:

"Identify or show evidence of at least 10 kinds of native plants found in your community.": Gardens, Trails, Nature Exchange, Resource Library

Star Rank Requirements:

"While a First Class Scout, take part in service projects totaling at least six hours of work. These projects must be approved by your Scoutmaster."

Life Rank Requirements:

"While a Star Scout, take part in service projects totaling at least six hours of work. These projects must be approved by your Scoutmaster."

Eagle Rank Requirements:

“While a Life Scout, plan, develop, and give leadership to others in a service project helpful to any religious institution, any school, or your community. (The project should benefit an organization other than Boy Scouting.) The project plan must be approved by the organization benefiting from the effort, your Scoutmaster and troop committee, and the council or district before you start. You must use the *Eagle Scout Leadership Service Project Workbook*, BSA publication No. 18-927, in meeting this requirement.” : Contact Springs Preserve Volunteerism Department
