**HOURS OF OPERATION:** **Summer: 10:00 a.m. -10:00 p.m.** (seven days a week)  
Winter: 10:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m. (seven days a week)  
The Preserve is closed on Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day. The Preserve may close early on days when concerts in the outdoor amphitheater are scheduled.

**ADMISSION:** There is no charge to visit the Gardens at the Springs Preserve or the Trails, however a ticket is required for admittance. For users of the Gardens and Trails, a donation is welcomed. The gift shop, resource library and the Springs Preserve Café are also free to the public. No ticket is required to utilize these areas. There is a charge for entrance into the Origen Experience and Desert Living Center galleries, and there will be a charge for admittance into the Nevada State Museum when it opens. **AMENITIES:**           **Guest Services** – Site maps and literature about upcoming events and educational classes can be found at Guest Services. Strollers, lockers and hand-held audio/video tours are available for rental.

- All areas of the Preserve are wheelchair accessible.
- With the exception of service animals, pets are not allowed at the Preserve to ensure wildlife is not disturbed and to protect archeological artifacts on the site.
- Bike riding is not permitted on the Preserve’s trail system.
- No outside food or drink is allowed into the Preserve.
