**Southwest Contractors 10th Annual Best of Nevada 2007 Awards 10/1/07**

*Southwest Contractor*, a leading construction industry publication serving the Southwest since 1938, held its 10th annual competition recognizing construction and design excellence in Nevada, Arizona and New Mexico. Over 700 entries were received in the tri-state region. There were 218 entries for Nevada, more than double last year's total. An independent jury comprised of eight design and construction professionals selected 24 winning projects among 22 categories.

Winning projects were chosen based on their quality of design and construction, innovation, contribution to the community, challenges overcome and overall excellence. Any juror who may have been affiliated with a submitted project abstained from voting in that category.
