A brief history of Día de Muertos

Día de Muertos—also known as “All Saints Day” and “Day of the Dead” among others—has been celebrated since the time of the Aztecs. It is believed that on that day the veil between the world of the living and the world of the dead is lifted, and the dearly departed are able to come back and visit their loved ones.

Families create altars (or memorials) for their dearly departed and decorate them with the departed one’s favorite food, drink and personal items for them to enjoy once more.

Altars should be decorated with the five basic elements of life:

EARTH: flowers and food

FIRE: candles

WIND: cut tissue paper

WATER: favorite drink of the departed

LOVE: personal mementos

Festivities are held on this day because, while it is a solemn event, it is not scary or sad. It is actually a celebration of life and of the life that was lived.
