- Be engaged with the lesson.
 - You are a role model for the kids around you and if they see that you are not paying attention, neither will they. We ask to this end that you limit texting and phone calls to actual emergencies.
- Stay with your assigned student group at all times. The Springs Preserve is an amazing place, but not without hazards. The only way to know what your children are up to is to be with them.
- In case of emergency, please contact Springs Preserve Security at 702-258-7101.
- Please remember to help us “Preserve the Preserve.” Have your students stay on paths and avoid disturbing plant life to both protect our beautiful space and to protect your students from potential injury. Many of our local plants come fully loaded with an exciting assortment of spines and thorns. Additionally, for the safety of you and your students do not touch the wildlife. They can and will bite or sting.
- Beverages, with the exception of water bottles with screw caps, are not allowed in museum spaces.
